Checking In

Upon arrival at Georgia Baptist Conference Center on Monday, July 10th, come to King Hotel Lobby, Room 11 to complete registration. Camp registration is between 12:00 noon and 3:00 p.m. The program officially begins with the Opening Team Meeting at 3:30 p.m. *Be prepared to take a swimming test during this time if you would like to swim during camp.*

The following items listed below are needed to complete your registration at check-in:

- Funds for Remaining Balance
- Student Permission Waiver Form (Enclosed)
- Copy of Insurance Card

It is **required** for a "Student Permission Waiver Form" be completed and signed by a parent or legal guardian in order to participate in activities at camp. If you enrolled online, you would have an opportunity to print this form. **Bring this form with you to camp for registration.**

Early Arrival

Camp housing is available after 12:00 p.m., Monday, July 10th. The first Camp meal is Monday evening at 6:00 p.m. Any housing or meals prior to Monday's dinner will have to be pre-arranged and paid for by the camper.

Fees

A deposit of \$160 was required upon registration. All unpaid fees are due at check-in at Camp.

What to Wear and Bring

Modest attire is required at all times during Camp. Such attire excludes clothing with drug, alcohol or sexually suggestive messages; cut-off t-shirts, inappropriately short shorts and tank tops showing undergarments. Keep your clothing and equipment simple; bring tennis shoes and equipment that you will need for competitions and clinics, and personal toiletries. Sheets and Towels are provided.

Bring your own personal gear such as water bottle, bug spray, sun block, or a small backpack. A notebook and pen or pencil will be needed for the Team Meetings.

Adults and children should bring suitable clothing and shoes for volleyball, kickball, etc.

Swimming facilities (lake) are available. All campers, 18 years and younger, will be required to take a swim test before being allowed to enter the lake. Modest swim attire is required - girls must wear a modest one-piece suit or colored t-shirt over their swimsuit.

Do not bring jewelry or other expensive items such as electronic devices. We cannot be responsible for the safekeeping of these items. Students are DISCOURAGED from bringing cell phones. If you decide to bring these items, remember you are responsible for their safekeeping.

Camp officially ends at 10:30 a.m., after the Team Chapel on Friday, July 14th.
