Checking In

Upon arrival at Georgia Baptist Conference Center on Thursday, December 21st, come to King Hotel Lobby, Room 11 to complete registration. Camp registration is between 3:30-6:00 p.m. The program officially begins with the Opening Team Meeting at 6:30 p.m.

The following items listed below are needed to complete your registration at check-in:

- Funds for Remaining Balance
- Student/Adult Permission Waiver
- Copy of Insurance Card

It is **required** for a Student Waiver Form be completed and signed by a parent or legal guardian in order to participate in activities at camp. If you enrolled online, and didn't print and already complete this form, please do so before camp.

Early Arrival

Camp housing is available after 1:00 p.m. Thursday, December 21st. The first Camp meal is Thursday evening at 7:00 p.m. Any housing or meals prior to Thursday's dinner will need to be taken care of by the camper or parent's before arriving at camp.

Fees

A non-refundable deposit of \$60 (adult) or \$80 (student) was required upon registration. All unpaid fees are due at check-in at Camp.

Cancellations can be made as late as the time of on-site check-in by emailing Lisa Hankins at lhankins@fca.org. All fees, **EXCEPT A \$50 SERVICE FEE**, will be refunded in January if you cancel your enrollment. Substitutions can be made as late as the time of on-site check-in.

What to Wear and Bring

Modest attire is required at all times during Camp. **Such attire excludes clothing with drug, alcohol or sexually suggestive messages; cut-off t-shirts, inappropriately short shorts and tank tops showing undergarments.** Keep your clothing and equipment simple; bring tennis shoes and equipment that you will need for competitions and clinics, and **personal toiletries. Sheets and Towels are provided.**

Bring your own personal gear such as water bottle, bug spray, sun block, or a small backpack. A notebook and pen or pencil will be needed for the Team Meetings.

This camp is in December so remember the weather will be cooler. Pack accordingly.

Adults and children should bring suitable clothing and shoes for volleyball, etc.

Do not bring jewelry or other expensive items such as cell phones or electronic devices. We cannot be responsible for the safe-keeping of these items. Students are DISCOURAGED from bringing cell phones. If you decide to bring these items, remember you are responsible for their safe keeping.
